

Tuition and Fees

The following costs for tuition and fees for the graduate religion programs are in effect as of July 1, 2019 and are valid through June 30, 2020:

Payment Options

Option A – Approximate for Total Package

Total package price may be paid in full by check, cashier's check, Discover, Visa, or MasterCard, and is due prior to the first day of class. Credit/debit card payments are subject to a 2% service charge. Total due depends on the number of courses taken in the academic year. Option B – Payment Plan

Students have the option to make monthly installments for the balance each term. Payment amounts will vary depending on the number of credit hours in the term. Please contact Student Financial Services at studentfinance@olivet.edu or 815-939-5245 for more details.

Option C – Financial Aid

Scholarships – A small number of scholarships are available through the ONU Foundation to graduate students in STCM grad programs. These scholarships are awarded, based on academic merit, to selected students who are either currently enrolled or who are admitted into the program by March 1 (prior to beginning of courses).

Study Fellowship – Each Spring, students in residential programs can apply for the Study Fellowship. This Fellowship, if awarded, provides the student with a 30% discount as long as the student maintains enrollment with an acceptable GPA in their program.

ONU Minister's Scholarship

This scholarship applies to any of the STCM grad programs. It is available to full-time, part-time, or volunteer lead and staff ministers in the Church of the Nazarene, subject to the recommendation of the presiding district superintendent. This scholarship is 50% of the tuition per semester as long as the student maintains enrollment with an acceptable GPA in their program.

There is also a 25% Minister's discount/scholarship for non-Nazarene pastors, all of the other qualifications still apply.

Student Loans – The primary form of financial assistance available to graduate students is the student loan. All questions regarding financial assistance and the necessary forms that must be completed and submitted to determine eligibility are available from the following office:
